**WHEREAS**, the provision of jobs to area citizens by local industry is both necessary and vital to the economic well-being of the City of Spring Hill, and



**WHEREAS**, on February 12, 2001 the Crown-Parks Partnership plans to construct an Assembly & Logistics Plant in the City of Spring Hill.


**WHEREAS**, the construction of an industrial access road to serve said proposed plant is necessary and vital to the successful completion of this project and the future economic well-being of this area.


