WHEREAS, the 2006-2007 Budget includes funds for the lease purchase of six (6) replacement vehicles for the Police Department; and


WHEREAS, the State of Tennessee has concluded their bid process and has made the list of low bidders and vehicles available to local governments;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, that the lease-purchase of six (6) police vehicles is hereby authorized utilizing the State of Tennessee bid process and the existing lease-purchase program through GMAC.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the vehicles shall be purchased at the following State bid price from the State authorized dealer;


