**A RESOLUTION TO REQUEST THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE TO INCORPORATE ONE (1) ZIP CODE FOR THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen for the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, by passage of this Resolution, hereby respectfully requests that the United States Postal Service consolidate the two (2) zip codes which serve the City of Spring Hill; and

**WHEREAS**, there currently are two (2) zip codes, 37174 and 37179, which serves the City and the consolidation of those codes into one code would be very beneficial to the citizens of our City.

**BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED** by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee that:

1. It has, by affirmative vote of this legislative body, requested that the United States Postal Service consider the consolidation of zip codes existing in the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee into one number which would serve the entire community.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that all Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith, be and the same hereby are repealed or modified as the case may be.
