
**A RESOLUTION TEMPORARILY LIFTING THE MORATORIUM ON  
CAPITAL PROJECTS FOR THE CITY OF SPRING HILL**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Mayor and Alderman of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, placed a moratorium on capital projects for the City of Spring Hill that become effective on January 22, 2008 and shall be effective for 90 days, or by recommendation of the Board of Mayor and Alderman.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen recognizes the need to improve traffic flow along U.S. Highway 31 (Main Street) while optimizing traffic movements from the signalized side streets.




