

RESOLUTION 08-21

**A RESOLUTION TO ADDRESS THE
VALIDITY OF THE TAXPAYER BILL OF RIGHTS**

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Alderman on the 21st day of July, 2003 passed Resolution 03-24, known as the Taxpayer Bill of Rights; and

WHEREAS, the Taxpayer Bill of Rights called for a referendum vote by the citizens of Spring Hill to approve any property tax increase; and

WHEREAS, this type of referendum is inconsistent with the Tennessee Constitution, Tennessee statutes and the Spring Hill Charter, and thus impermissible by law; and

WHEREAS, resolution 03-24, known as the Taxpayer Bill of Rights should be rescinded as it is of no legal effect.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Mayor and Alderman of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee that Resolution 03-24, the Taxpayer Bill of Rights is rescinded as consistent with Tennessee State Law.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.


