A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT THE PROPOSAL OF WILBUR SMITH ASSOCIATES FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING/DESIGN SERVICES TO ASSIST IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS AND WIDENING OF DUPLEX ROAD (SR 247) IN ACCORDANCE WITH TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (TDOT) GUIDELINES AND STANDARDS.


WHEREAS, there is a critical need for improvements to Duplex Road (SR 247);

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill has advertised Requests for Proposals for this project from qualified professional engineering firms and were submitted, on or before 4:00 p.m., February 6, 2009 for services listed as follows:


- Environmental Documentation meeting all State and Federal requirements necessary to secure project funding.
- Field topographic and property surveys.
- Geotechnical investigation and recommendations.
- Design of all improvements, including relocation of utilities, and preparation of construction plans and specifications.
- Acquisition of proposed right-of-way including property appraisals, negotiations with property owners, and relocation services as needed.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Mayor and Aldermen accept the recommendation of City Staff and begin negotiations with Wilbur Smith Associates for professional engineering/design services. Such amount shall be brought back to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen for approval and ratification of that negotiated amount at a future public meeting.


