

RESOLUTION 10-105

**A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY OF SPRING HILL BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN
TO APPROVE A SETTLEMENT IN
CECIL HARDEN VS. SPRING HILL POLICE DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill is involved in litigation in regard to certain actions or inactions of the Spring Hill Police Department;

WHEREAS, counsel for the City of Spring Hill has recommended an offer of a settlement to address all unresolved issues in this lawsuit;

WHEREAS, by approving the payment of this settlement, the City of Spring Hill maintains that it is not at fault in this case; and

WHEREAS, counsel for the City of Spring Hill, has negotiated a settlement for a total amount of \$7,500.00, in consideration of a release by him of all claims against the City of Spring Hill. This claim to be settled as follows: The City of Spring Hill will pay Cecil Harden \$1,250.00; TML Risk Management Pool will issue check to Cecil Harden in the amount of \$6,250.00; the City of Spring Hill will pay TML Risk Management Pool \$2,500.00 deductible,

WHEREAS, The Board of Mayor and Aldermen feels that this settlement offer and the Resolution of the acceptance of such offer is in the best interest of all the citizens of Spring Hill, Tennessee, and hereby formally accepts the terms of such agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, that the settlement is hereby accepted upon the condition that the Plaintiff release and further hold harmless the City from any and all liability as alleged in this lawsuit.
