

RESOLUTION 10-31

A RESOLUTION ALLOWING CERTAIN PROPERTY OWNED BY THE CITY OF SPRING HILL TO BE UTILIZED AS A TEMPORARY T-BALL FIELD FOR SPRING HILL LITTLE LEAGUE

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill is the owner of land at 555 Maury Hill Street, which is a vacant lot beside the Winchester Community Facility, purchase authorized by Resolution 07-05; and

WHEREAS, the property is currently being used as additional parking for events held at the Winchester Community Facility; and

WHEREAS, the Spring Hill Little League requests that this lot be used to develop a temporary T-ball field for three and four year old children; and


WHEREAS, the T-ball field will not exceed 90 feet, while having 50 foot base distances, with a temporary backstop constructed with 6 foot chain link fencing, which is currently available at no cost to the City, and Spring Hill Little League has agreed to provide temporary outfield fencing; and

WHEREAS, the Spring Hill Parks and Recreation Commission and Department recommends that the City approve this request for a temporary T-ball field; and

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill, Board of Mayor and Aldermen believes that it is in the best interest of the community.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill that City property at 555 Maury Hill Street be utilized as a temporary T-ball field for Spring Hill Little League.


