

RESOLUTION 10-102

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE MAURY COUNTY ELECTION COMMISSION TO CONDUCT AN ELECTION WITHIN THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE, ON THURSDAY, APRIL 14, 2011, TO ELECT ONE (1) ALDERMAN FROM EACH OF THE FOUR (4) WARDS, PURSUANT TO THE ELECTION LAWS OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, that:

The Maury County Election Commission is requested and authorized to conduct the regular municipal election for the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, on Thursday, April 14, 2011, for the purpose of electing one (1) Alderman from each of the four (4) wards, all to be voted on at-large by the registered voters of the city, each Alderman to serve a term of four (4) years. The Maury County Election Commission is requested to publish notice of the election in both Maury and Williamson Counties.



Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee on the 18th day of October, 2010.




