**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE PURCHASE
OF A REPLACEMENT POLICE VEHICLE USING INSURANCE
RECOVERY MONEY AND ADDITIONAL FUNDS**

WHEREAS, the Spring Hill Police Department lost a vehicle and needs to replace it; and

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill received an insurance recovery amount of \$19,677.40 from TML Risk Management Pool; and

WHEREAS, there is an opportunity to purchase a replacement on state contract in the amount of \$21,530.00 from Alexander Chevrolet; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Spring Hill authorizes the purchase of a vehicle on state contract in the amount of \$21,530.00, using \$19,677.40 in insurance recovery funds and the remaining \$1,852.60 from city (general) fund, as recommended by the Budget and Finance Advisory Committee on May 9, 2011.
