**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE PURCHASE
OF ADDITIONAL LAND FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A
LARGER WATER TANK ON BUCKNER ROAD**

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill is in need of a larger water tank on the north side of town; and

WHEREAS, in order to improve water pressure and maintain adequate supply, the City of Spring Hill desires to provide for its citizens by building a larger water tank; and

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill can obtain land from the Magli Family in order to accomplish this critical task; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Spring Hill authorizes the purchase of additional land from the Magli Family for the construction of a one million gallon water tank on Buckner Road in the amount of \$21,000.00.


**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE PURCHASE OF

TANK AND ACQUIRING EASEMENT FOR WATER LINE
RELOCATION**

WHEREAS, the citizens of Spring Hill are in need of a water tank on Buckner Road; and


WHEREAS, in order to adequately supply the need of water to the citizens on the north side of Spring Hill, a tank must be built as soon as possible; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Spring Hill, Board of Mayor and Aldermen authorizes the purchase of additional land required to build a water tank on Buckner Road and the cost of acquiring an easement for water line relocation. Land and easement is not to exceed \$25,000.00 and will be drawn from the Water-Sewer fund.


