WHEREAS, the MS4 Department is in need of a Pickup Truck with Dump Body; and


WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill accepted proposals from qualified vendors on October 4, 2011; and



WHEREAS, the MS4 Department is in need of a Pickup Truck with Dump Body; and


WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill approved funding of a Pickup Truck with a Dump Body in the 2011-2012 Capital Improvement Plan; and

WHEREAS, Staff has submitted a recommendation to the Budget Finance Advisory Committee; and



Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee on the 17th day of October, 2011.





MS4 Department Recommendation

After review of all bid documentation the MS4 Department makes the following recommendations. Recommendations are in order of suggested preference.

Five of these bids are for nearly identical Ford 550 trucks and one Dodge 5500.

Pros and cons are listed with each bid recommendation below where there are any.

All of these vehicles will perform the required service needed for the MS4 and Public Works

1) Miracle Ford – Ford 550 \$46,587.00 (16 week to deliver – 4 months)

Truck meets all requested specs for MS4 and Public Works that were requested. Best price.

2) Sam Swope Auto Group - Dodge 5500 \$50995.15 (90-120 day delivery - 3 to 4 months)

Truck meets all requested specs for MS4 and Public Works that were requested.

Cummins Diesel engine is a strong power train. May be worth the extra cost considering the heavy usage of the vehicle. Downside is the extra cost.

3) Sloan Ford – Ford 550 50,148.00 (4-5 weeks delivery - 1 month roughly)

Local dealer in Columbia. Higher cost. Quicker delivery than above bids. Vehicle meets all specs requested by MS4 and Public Works. Extra items included but not requested drive up cost are listed below.

Heavy Duty Alternator

PTO takeoff

Cruise

AM/FM/CD

Chrome bumper

4) Country Ford – Ford 550

Two costs based on delivery date: (\$48, 128.52 – 6-8 week 1 ½ to 2 months) (\$48, 822.08 – 10 day delivery)

10 Day delivery a benefit but with a price.

Vehicle meets all specs requested by MS4 and Public Works.

5) Town and Country Ford – Ford 550 \$47,198.00 110 day delivery - 3 ½ months

Same truck 2nd lowest in price bid. Meets all specs requested by MS4 and Public Works.

6) Ford of Murfreesboro – Ford 550 \$48,134.00 180 day deliveries – 6 months

Extremely long delivery date. Other vehicles available quicker for a lower price.

Meets all specs requested by MS4 and Public Works.
