
WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Alderman wishes to establish a list of priorities that is congruent with the Transportation Advisory Committee's recommendation, and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the following items, listed in order of priority be established for Transportation Advisory Committee:


- 1) 2012-2013 Budgetary Issues for Road Improvement Plan funding
- 2) 2012-2013 Budgetary Issues for Street Resurfacing Plan funding
- 3) 2012-2017 Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) funding for transportation and related issues
- 4) Develop a Neighborhood Traffic Calming Policy for recommendation to the BOMA
- 5) Prepare and Recommend to the Planning Commission updated Street Cross-Section Design Standards for the Planning Commission Subdivision Regulations
- 6) Develop and Recommend to the BOMA an Implementation Plan for Transportation Issues
- 7) Prepare and Recommend to the BOMA and Planning Commission a Future Greenways and Multi-Modal Transportation Map
- 8) Recommend to BOMA a Neighborhood Sidewalk Plan
- 9) Consider adopting a Complete Streets Policy for the City


