WHEREAS, Mr. Kyle Riddle is a Lifeguard at Longview Recreational Center in Spring Hill Tennessee.


WHEREAS, at approximately 5:30 p.m. on Thursday, August 9, 2012 Kyle Riddle was monitoring the outdoor pool by the play structure at Longview Recreation Center where a mother and her two small children were playing by the yellow slide, the mother picked up her 4 year old son and yelled to Kyle that they needed help. Kyle responded and met the mother at the zero entry and noticed that the child was unconscious.

WHEREAS, Kyle utilized his training and skills and applied one rescue breath to the unconscious child, reviving the child who coughed up water and began to cry; the child became alert and began to walk around and was taken to the hospital for precautionary observation; and

WHEREAS, in the performance of his duties as Lifeguard, Mr. Riddle rendered emergency care to a person whose life was in immediate jeopardy, and did so in a manner that most certainly sustained the young boy and enabled the individual to completely recover from a near-drowning.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that The City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, does with great pride, hereby acknowledge and recognize heroic life saving act & achievements of Mr. Kyle Riddle


