**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE DUCK RIVER ELECTRIC TO

**WHEREAS**, Duck River Electric is the sole provider of street lights in this territory and has submitted a cost estimate of \$213.00 per month for 14 street lights;


**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City of Spring Hill authorizes Duck River Electric to install street lights on Kedron Road.



**ORDINANCE NO. 05-45**

**AN ORDINANCE TO ANNEX PROPERTY BELONGING TO MAURY COUNTY, A ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY KNOWN AS KEDRON ROAD, FROM THE WESTERN RIGHT OF WAY OF PORT ROYAL ROAD AS EXTENDED ACROSS KEDRON ROAD, TO THE WESTERN RIGHT OF WAY OF INTERSTATE 65 , TO THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL**

**Whereas, it appears that the prosperity of the City of Spring Hill and the affected territory will be materially deficient unless the territories as above described are annexed to the corporate limits of the City; and**

**Whereas, the natural growth areas of the City will include the land parcels on either side of the above described road rights-of-way**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE:**

That pursuant to TCA 6-51-101, et seq., the property vested in Maury County, Tennessee, namely the right-of way of Kedron Road from the western right-of-way of Port Royal road as extended across Kedron road to the Western right-of-way of Interstate 65, is hereby annexed to the corporate limits of the City of Spring Hill and made a part thereof.

A map showing the said territory is available for inspection at City Hall in Spring Hill, Tennessee.

This ordinance was passed after the adoption of a plan of services for the property in conformity with, and as provided by TCA 6-51-102.

This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after its final passage.

Jeff,

Sorry it's taken so long to get this price to you. Our engineering department in Shelbyville has to figure the costs and they have 6 other districts and their projects to contend with along with ours. Thank you for your patience.

The quote for the street light circuit that includes 14 – 250 watt high pressure sodium fixtures, 4 poles, pole hardware and conductor is \$10,500. The actual cost of the installation would be placed in the street light investment program that DREMC has in place with City of Spring Hill. The estimated monthly increase to the city would be as follows:

\$105.29 --Monthly Investment Amount - actual cost of installation x 12% annual facility charge / 12 months

\$107.71 - Monthly Energy charge - 14 lights (based on January 2013 rate)

\$213.00 Total Estimate Cost per Month

I do need to make you aware that this lighting plan will not provide a high level of lighting due to the distance between lights, but as typical in most cities, installing lights on every other pole is common place along city roads. Being this area was a rural area when our power line was constructed, we used longer span lengths which is why the distance will be a little long when lights are placed every other pole. This level of lighting should be satisfactory in this area but I wanted to make you aware.

If City of Spring Hill would like to move forward with the street light circuit on Kedron Road, please send DREMC a formal request.
