WHEREAS, after legal proceedings, the Maury County Circuit Court released and awarded said property to the Spring Hill Police Department; and


WHEREAS, Spring Hill Police Department Detectives have attempted to make contact with the owner(s) of the property without success; and



Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, on the 22nd day of April, 2013.




