RESOLUTION EXPRESSING OFFICIAL INTENT THAT CERTAIN EXPENDITURES TO BE INCURRED IN CONNECTION WITH THE PURCHASE OF A FIRE RESCUE TRUCK AND A DUMP TRUCK BE REIMBURSED FROM PROCEEDS OF NOTES, BONDS, OR OTHER INDEBTEDNESS TO BE ISSUED BY THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE


WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee is in the process of incurring certain capital expenditures to be made with respect to the purchase of a fire rescue truck and dump truck; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen desires to establish its official intent that certain expenditures related to the purchase of a fire rescue truck and dump truck be reimbursed out of notes, bonds, or other indebtedness to be issued in the future by the City of Spring Hill; and

WHEREAS, if the Fire Rescue truck and Dump Truck are delivered prior to financing, the proceeds of such indebtedness will be used to reimburse the General Fund, \$431,475.00 for the Fire Rescue Truck and \$78,235.00 for a Dump Truck.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE, establishes the intent that the expenditures totaling **\$509,710.00** in connection with the purchase of a Fire Rescue Truck and Dump Truck be reimbursed from proceeds of financing.



WHEREAS, the Spring Hill Fire Department is in need of a Rescue Truck and extrication equipment to better serve the citizens of Spring Hill; and


WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill accepted proposals from qualified vendors on August 17, 2012; and

WHEREAS, city staff have reviewed the proposals and made a recommendation to the Budget and Finance Advisory Committee; and


