**WHEREAS**, the City of Spring Hill included thirteen new vehicles with equipment in the budget, for fiscal year 2013-2014.




**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City of Spring Hill authorizes the purchase of the equipment from:

**RE:** Vehicle equipment purchase

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**OVERVIEW:** The Spring Hill Police Department was allocated 13 new police vehicles in the 2013-14 budget, which included the purchase price of the vehicles and equipment. A RFP was submitted for the ancillary equipment to outfit all vehicles, and other equipment is to be purchased from quotes or State Contracts.

**HIGHLIGHTS:**

- This purchase is to outfit the new vehicles with the needed equipment in order to make the vehicles functional for Law Enforcement duties.

**PROJECT/CONTRACT UPDATES:**

- The RFP bids were opened on August 29, 2013, with two vendors responding. ON Duty Depot and Truckers Lighthouse. (see attached bid sheets) Other equipment will be purchased off of State Contract or from quotes, and the awarded vendor will do the installs. On Duty Depot's total bid for all vehicles is \$72,605.38. Truckers Lighthouse's total bid for all vehicles is \$72,393.95. (difference of \$211.43)
- On Duty Depot will be warranting previous installs that Harpeth Motors performed on our vehicles. Their employees are trained and certified in vehicle installations. By having one vendor do the installs for all vehicles, all the specs and equipment will be the same. It will be easier having one vendor to work with instead of two.
