WINTER STREET SCAPE BANNER DESIGN**



## STREETSCAPE AND HOLIDAY DECORATION

For the last couple of years we have worked to rehab our Christmas wreath decorations that are displayed along Main Street. Funds were allocated this budget year to replace these worn out wreaths. After looking at the hundreds of options a plan has been developed for new holiday decoration displays. The intent is to replace half (30) of the wreaths with a LED Snowflake display and the other half with 30 Holiday Banners. A decision was made to go with a “winter” theme and be able to utilize the displays through the winter months and not have to remove them immediately after the holidays. The use of the banners will allow us to add other seasonal displays or even utilize them for special events since the mounting hardware will be there year round.
