WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill wishes to purchase and install 4 shade structures at Harvey Park, 2 at Walnut Street Skate Park as well as drive through style trash receptacles at Port Royal Park and Harvey Park; and

WHEREAS, city staff has made a recommendation to the Budget and Finance Advisory Committee; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Spring Hill, Board of Mayor and Aldermen authorizes the purchase of:


Single Post – in ground mount shade canopy \$2,284.00 each x 6	\$13,704.00

STAFF MEMORANDUM

PURPOSE

The parks and recreation would like to purchase the following equipment.

Shade structures are needed to provide needed shaded areas at Harvey Park and Walnut Street Skate Park.

Drive through waste containers strategically placed at Port Royal Park and Harvey Park will allow park participants to easily dispose of waste while entering or exiting the park and without leaving their car. This should help eliminate the amount of trash being left in the parking areas.

Single Post – in ground mount shade canopy \$2,284.00 each x 6	\$13,704.00
Waste Container /drive through lid \$273.00 each x 2	\$ 546.00
TOTAL	\$15,432.07

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The department currently has \$16,000.00 budgeted in the 2015-2016 budget for the purchase of the shade structures and the savings allows for the trash containers. The cost of this equipment is under budget.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Favorable Recommendation – the shade structures was recommended by the Parks and Recreation Commission due to public comments and concerns.
