

RESOLUTION 15-143

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 15-10 TO EXTEND THE TERM
OF THE SPRING HILL BATTLEFIELD TASK FORCE

WHEREAS, recognizing the need to preserve and protect the integrity of Spring Hill Battlefield, while also taking into consideration the rights of private land owners, accommodating future transportation needs and the economic needs of the City, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill adopted Resolution 15-10, a Resolution to Establish a Spring Hill Battlefield Task Force to assist the Board in exploring these issues, the opportunities that may exist and actions that may be taken to preserve Spring Hill Battlefield; and


WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 15-10, Section 1, the term of the Spring Hill Battlefield Task Force is to expire on the earlier of December 31, 2015, or immediately following the presentation to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of such reports or recommendations as directed by Resolution 15-10 establishing its charge; and

WHEREAS, the Spring Hill Battlefield Task Force has yet to complete its charge and requests an extension of the expiration date of December 31, 2015 to June 30, 2016.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE THAT:


Section 1: Amendment. Section 1: Creation. of Resolution 15-10 is hereby amended to replace the date December 31, 2015 with the date June 30, 2016.

Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee on the 21st day of December, 2015.




