WHEREAS, the Police Department was allocated to purchase new police vehicles with equipment in the current 2016-17 budget; and


WHEREAS, the Police Department advertised a RFP for police package vehicles and received bids; and

WHEREAS; City staff has reviewed prior proposals and has made a recommendation to the Budget and Finance Advisory Committee.



Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee on the 19th day of December, 2016.




