Whereas, this area includes the Corporate Limits of SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE, and the McCutcheon and Rutherford Creek Service Areas which are within and contiguous to the City of SPRING HILL and,

Whereas, the City of COLUMBIA, TENNESSEE, has agreed to be the lead applicant for the Step 1 Planning Grant for this area,


