

RESOLUTION NO. 77-05

WHEREAS, at a meeting on July 26, 1977, a task force consisting of representatives of the Williamson County Court, the Williamson County Chamber of Commerce, the Maury County Court, the Maury County Chamber of Commerce, and the Town of Spring Hill has requested that the two courts and the Town of Spring Hill prepare resolutions and applications to the Tennessee Department of Transportation for a feasibility study of an interchange at the junction of I-65 and the Duplex Road with an access road to Spring Hill, and

WHEREAS, a representative of the Department of Transportation who was present at that meeting stated that such a study would be prepared by that Department without cost to the Counties and Town involved upon the passage of such resolutions and the receipt of such an application,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Town of Spring Hill that such a study be conducted and that the Town participate with the two Counties in the application to the Department of Transportation for this study.
