
WHEREAS, the vehicle will be for the Utility Administration Department; and

WHEREAS, the State contract pricing through Wilson County Motors shall not exceed \$40,000.00 for the 2025 Chevrolet Blazer; and


WHEREAS, funding for the purchase of the vehicle was included in budget amendment #1, Ordinance 24-21 (410-52010-59411 - \$40,000.00).

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this resolution is to approve the purchase of a vehicle for the Utility Administration Department through (Sourcewell) State contract.

BACKGROUND:

The vehicle will be purchased as a work vehicle for the Utility Administration Department. Funding was included in Ordinance 24-21. Staff is requesting to purchase a 2025 Chevrolet Blazer from Wilson County Motors not to exceed \$40,000.00.

Additional safety measures (safety lights, City logo, etc.) will be added to the vehicle as needed.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The funding for the vehicle will be from the Utility Administration Department (410-52010-59411). Budgeted funds is \$40,000.00
