

RESOLUTION 25-91

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE MAURY COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL BOARD TO GRANT A 75-FOOT RIGHT-OF-WAY ALONG MAHLON MOORE ROAD AND BATTLE CREEK WAY

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, is dedicated to improving transportation infrastructure and ensuring the safety and accessibility of its roads and surrounding areas for its residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, Mahlon Moore Road and Battle Creek Way are vital roadways within the City of Spring Hill that provide critical access to local neighborhoods and educational facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill has identified the need for a 75-foot right-of-way along Mahlon Moore Road and Battle Creek Way to support ongoing and future infrastructure improvements, including road widening and other improvements necessary for the safe and efficient movement of traffic; and

WHEREAS, the right-of-way requested from the Maury County Public School Board is located along properties owned or managed by the Board that are adjacent to the aforementioned roadways; and

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill is committed to working collaboratively with the Maury County Public School Board to ensure that all necessary easements are obtained in a manner that respects the needs and concerns of the Board and its facilities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE:

1. That the Board of Mayor and Alderman hereby requests the Maury County Public School Board to grant the City of Spring Hill a 75-foot right-of-way along Mahlon Moore Road and Battle Creek Way for the purpose of improving road infrastructure, pedestrian safety, and public access.

2. That the City of Spring Hill will work in cooperation with the Maury County Public School Board to ensure that all necessary legal and administrative steps are taken to secure the right-of-way in a manner that minimizes impact on school property and operations.


