

## **RESOLUTION 25-92**

### **A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A PARTNERSHIP IN FUNDING ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS FOR MAHLON MOORE ROAD AND BATTLE CREEK WAY**

**WHEREAS**, the safety of students, staff, and the public is of paramount importance to the City of Spring Hill, and the City is committed to ensuring that all infrastructure supports the safe and efficient movement of traffic around key areas, especially near schools; and

**WHEREAS**, Mahlon Moore Rd and Battle Creek Way are critical routes serving the schools in the area, and are heavily used by staff, students, parents, and school buses daily; and

**WHEREAS**, safety concerns have been raised regarding the current condition and design of the intersections of Mahlon Moore Rd and Battle Creek Way, with particular focus on increasing traffic congestion, potential accidents, and hazardous conditions that compromise the safety of school children, staff, and the general public; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Spring Hill recognizes the urgency of addressing these safety concerns to protect the children and staff of the Maury County Public Schools, as well as other travelers in the area; and

**WHEREAS**, it is recognized that improving the roadways at these intersections will provide long-term benefits to the community, including reduced risk of accidents, smoother traffic flow, and safer travel for students and school personnel; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Spring Hill is committed to making the necessary improvements to Mahlon Moore Rd and Battle Creek Way and has identified an estimated funding need of \$1,000,000 for the design and implementation of intersection safety improvements; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Spring Hill seeks to collaborate with Maury County and Maury County Public Schools to ensure these critical roadway safety improvements are completed in a timely manner for the benefit of all stakeholders; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, that the City of Spring Hill hereby requests the partnership of Maury County, Tennessee, and Maury County Public Schools in funding a portion of the estimated \$1,000,000 necessary for the roadway improvements at the intersections of Mahlon Moore Rd and Battle Creek Way, with the sole purpose of improving safety for school children, staff, and other travelers.



**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a formal agreement shall be entered into by all parties outlining the specific roles, responsibilities, and contributions of each organization in funding, planning, and executing these safety improvements.
