

**RESOLUTION NO. 25-96**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE TO APPOINT A VICE-MAYOR**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Spring Hill is governed by a Board of Mayor and Aldermen consisting of eight aldermen, two from each of the City's four wards, and a Mayor elected at large; and

**WHEREAS**, per the provisions of the City's Charter and applicable ordinances, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen is authorized to appoint a Vice-Mayor from among its members; and

**WHEREAS**, the role of the Vice-Mayor is to preside over meetings and perform the duties of the Mayor in the event of the Mayor's absence or inability to act; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen recognizes the importance of maintaining clear and continuous leadership and desires to appoint a member of the Board to serve in this vital role;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE, as follows:**

**SECTION 1.** That Alderman Trent Linville, is hereby appointed to serve as Vice-Mayor of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee.

**SECTION 2.** That the Vice-Mayor shall serve in accordance with the provisions of the City Charter and applicable laws and shall perform the duties and responsibilities of the Mayor in the Mayor's absence or inability to act.

**SECTION 3.** That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption, the public welfare requiring it.


