

RESOLUTION 25-232

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE, AUTHORIZING FUNDING TO THE SPRING HILL CHAMBER OF COMMERCE FOR THE CELEBRATION OF THE 250TH ANNIVERSARY OF AMERICA'S INDEPENDENCE

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill recognizes the historic significance of the 250th anniversary of the founding of the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, community celebrations, including fireworks, festivals, and public events, provide cultural, social, and economic benefits to the citizens of Spring Hill and its visitors; and

WHEREAS, the Spring Hill Chamber of Commerce has agreed to facilitate and coordinate the 2026 Fourth of July Fireworks Show commemorating the nation's 250th birthday; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen (BOMA) desire to support this event through the Tourism Fund as a one-time donation, with appropriate accountability and claw back provisions;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:


1. The City of Spring Hill shall provide funding to the Spring Hill Chamber of Commerce in an amount **not to exceed \$80,000** from the Tourism Fund as a one-time donation to facilitate the 2026 Fourth of July Fireworks Celebration.
2. The funds shall be disbursed as follows:
 - o **\$40,000 initial payment** upon approval of this resolution.
 - o **\$20,000 by January 1, 2026**, if the additional \$40,000 needed has not been secured through sponsorships, donations, or grants.
 - o **\$20,000 by March 1, 2026**, if sponsorships, donations, or grants remain insufficient to fully fund the event.
3. **Claw back Provision:** Any unused funds, or funds secured through sponsorships, donations, or grants in excess of the amount required to fund the event, shall be returned to the City of Spring Hill.
4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
