

RESOLUTION 17-53

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND RESOLUTION 11-122, REGARDING MEMBERSHIP OF THE SPRING HILL TRANSPORTATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE


WHEREAS, on November 21, 2011, the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen passed Resolution 11-122, establishing a committee for the purpose of assisting in the development of a strategic transportation plan and to make recommendations on annual transportation priorities for Capital Improvement Plan funding, and;

WHEREAS, the committee consisted of two members of the Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen and one member of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen desires to expand the membership from three positions to seven positions, consisting of one additional alderman and 3 citizens. The first citizen appointee shall serve a term expiring on December 31, 2017; the second citizen appointee shall serve a term expiring on December 31, 2018; the third citizen appointee shall serve a term expiring on December 31, 2019; three year terms take effect for citizen appointees thereafter. The alderman appointee shall run concurrent with the term of office.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Spring Hill authorizes the amendment of Resolution 11-122, expanding the membership from three to 7 positions on the Transportation Advisory Committee, consisting of one additional alderman and 3 citizens, as stated above.


