Rippavilla partners with Spring Hill High to host free harvest fest, antique tractor/car show

SPRING HILL – Just in time for the winding down of summer, come out and enjoy the free Harvest Festival and Antique Tractor Show at Rippavilla, while supporting two great nonprofit causes.

This family-friendly event will be jointly hosted from 9 a.m. – 4 p.m. Saturday, Sept. 14, by historic Rippavilla and Spring Hill High School (SHHS) Career Tech Program, with proceeds benefiting both organizations.

It's a day to celebrate the harvest as our forefathers did with living history exhibits, including butter churning, basket weaving, stain glass making, and soap making, to name a few. It's also a unique opportunity to see antique tractors and classic cars on the beautiful sprawling grounds of Rippavilla.

The event will host local bands throughout the day, bringing lively entertainment for all. A variety of food trucks and vendors will have items for sale. There are plans to have yard games for young and old alike.

Rippavilla Plantation, located in the heart of Spring Hill, Tennessee, features a stunning 1850s Greek Revival mansion, built by Nathaniel and Susan Cheairs. It is complete with original family antiques, heirlooms and Civil War artifacts. The grounds, which span 98 acres, including antique barn, family and slave cemeteries, Freedman's Bureau school house, original slave quarters, the Battlefield of Spring Hill (precursor to the famous Battle of Franklin) and a gift shop. Rippavilla Plantation is open daily for guided tours, field trips and family outings, and is the venue for many popular events.

Rippavilla Plantation, listed on the National Register for Historic Places, is currently maintained and operated by Rippavilla, Inc., a non-profit 501(c)3 organization. All proceeds from the Harvest Festival benefit the operation and restoration of the historic mansion and outbuildings as well as various clubs at Spring Hill High School.
