**Whereas**, a Spring Hill Police Department vehicle was involved in a traffic crash and was deemed totaled by TML insurance; and

**Whereas**, the replacement value received for the loss of the 2015 Chevrolet Impala was \$16,153.31; and


**Whereas**, the Spring Hill Police Department request to purchase a replacement vehicle on State Contract (209/56446) from Ford of Murfreesboro, using the proceeds from the insurance company with remaining balance to be paid from current budget; and

**Whereas**, the replacement vehicle, a 2018 Ford Fusion S, will be placed back into rotation and used by the detective's division; and

**Whereas**; City staff has reviewed prior proposals and has made a recommendation to the Budget and Finance Advisory Committee;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City of Spring Hill authorizes the purchase a 2018 Ford Fusion from State Contract 209/56446 from Ford of Murfreesboro, for \$18,812.00 to replace an existing police vehicle involved in a vehicular crash as recommended by the Budget and Finance Advisory Committee on June 4, 2018.

Department Budget Status:

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I. Purpose/Overview: To replace a police vehicle involved in a vehicular crash that was deemed totaled by the insurance company.

II. Background Information: A 2015 Chevrolet Impala was involved in a wreck here in Spring Hill. We received a claim of \$16,153.31 for the damage to the Impala. This was a fleet vehicle used by a detective. State Contract list the Chevrolet Malibu at \$17,928.26. This is the lowest price sedan on state contract. The Impala is listed at \$20,341.00. The difference will be paid for out of current budget.

III. Financial Impact to Budget. \$1,774.50

IV. Alternative Options: Find and purchase used vehicle.

V. Staff Recommendations: Purchase Chevrolet Malibu from Wilson County Motors off of State Contract to replace totaled police vehicle, using insurance claim and remainder of balance to be paid from current budget.
