

RESOLUTION 18-154

A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE CONDITIONS OF UTILITY CUT ON MAHLON MOORE ROAD

WHEREAS, it is generally a policy of the City of Spring Hill to not allow open cuts for utilities across roadways functionally classified as arterial roadways; and

WHEREAS, the Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen wishes to review and approve each open cut request individually; and

WHEREAS, the Maury County School Board is constructing a middle school on property located near Mahlon Moore Road that necessitates the installation of a water main for fire protection that subsequently requires a street cut across Mahlon Moore Road; and

WHEREAS, the Maury County School Board provides herein a request open cut Mahlon Moore Road to facilitate and expedite the construction of the water main; and


WHEREAS, the extenuating field conditions present to extend the water line from the eastside of Mahlon Moore Road to the westside of Mahlon Moore make boring extremely difficult.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen authorize an open street cut on Mahlon Moore Road for the purpose of constructing a water main to provide fire protection to the middle school currently under construction with the following conditions:

1. The Maury County School Board and their contractor performing the work will conduct construction activities between the hours of 8:30a.m CST and 2:30pm CST daily. No work will be permitted on weekend unless the contractor agrees to reimburse the city for inspection services provided by city workers. Other hours may be acceptable for Saturday and Sunday and must be agreed upon by the City Administrator or his appointee.
2. The Maury County School Board and their contractor performing the work will place suitable temporary stone fill material and/or steel plates over the excavation each day to provide a drivable surface when construction is not being performed.
3. The Maury County School Board and their contractor performing the work shall make every reasonable effort to avoid a complete street closure while performing the construction work. In the event a complete closure of the street will be required, the contractor shall provide the City with a minimum 48-hour notice so that appropriate public notification can be provided. A detour plan shall be reviewed and approved by the City prior to permitting a complete closure of the street.
4. The Maury County School Board and their contractor performing the work shall provide traffic control devices, signage and personnel to manage traffic flow through


- the construction zone during construction hours. Appropriate warning signage shall be placed along Mahlon Moore Road warning motorists of construction zone.
5. Following installation of the binder course of asphalt, the excavation will be monitored by the Maury County School Board and their contractor and the City to track settlement following installation. The Maury County School Board and their contractor will be responsible for any repairs necessary to address settlement of the cut for a period of one year.
 6. The Maury County School Board and their contractor shall install a final wearing course of asphalt approximately sixty calendar days following the installation of the binder course. The final course shall extend a minimum of 20 feet on either side of the excavation cut and will include proper restriping of the road surface to MUTCD standards.

Dear Thomas,

On behalf of our client, Maury County Public Schools, we are respectfully requesting your approval and positive recommendation to the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Alderman (BOMA) for the open cutting of Mahlon Moore Road to install the new water service to serve Battle Creek Middle School.

We are in receipt of your letter dated August 20, 2018 (attached) and we are in agreement with the conditions outlined, which are;

- Prepare a traffic control/detour plan in conformance with the requirements of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Street and Highways (MUTCD). Plan will be submitted to the City of Spring Hill for review and approval prior to construction commencing.
- Traffic control/detour signage shall be installed in conformance with the City approved plan.
- Work hours for the roadway cutting will be limited from 8:30 AM to 2:30 PM.
- Mahlon Moore Road shall be open to through traffic outside of the work hours noted above.
- We will ensure that a sufficient number of steel plates shall be available at the project site for use in order to provide through traffic on Mahlon Moore Road.
