2018-2019 PROPERTY CONSERVATION MATCHING GRANT**


WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen approved grant application for the Public Entity Partners 2018-2019 Property Conservation Matching Grant on October 15, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the application was submitted by City staff and approved by Public Entity Partners.

WHEREAS, the \$4,500 in grant funds will be allocated between the General Fund (\$945) and Water/Sewer Fund (\$3,555) based upon the pro-rata costs for the installations of cameras and equipment for the Library and Wastewater Treatment Plant and incorporated within a future budget amendment.


