SPRING HILL**


**WHEREAS**, the City of Spring Hill has purchased aerial data from Pictometry International Corp in the past; and

**WHEREAS**, the quoted price for the Spring Hill portion of aerial data is \$18,000.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, their intent to support the funding of Pictometry aerial data in the 2019-2020 Fiscal Budget as recommended by the Budget and Finance Advisory Committee on February 4, 2019.

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- I. Purpose: Pictometry 2019 Maury County Flight.
- II. Background Information:
  - a. Spring Hill has participated with Maury County, Columbia and Mt Pleasant in Pictometry flights for aerial data since 2007.
  - b. Flights are on a three-year cycle. Pictometry plans to conduct a flight in February 2019.
  - c. Pictometry's proposed contract is for 2 flight cycles to lock in the cost. The 2019 cost is \$130,159.39. This project includes \$36,069.39 for LiDar data being purchased by Columbia. The 2022 Pictometry project cost is \$94,090.
  - d. Spring Hill's portion of the 2019 project is projected to be \$18,000. Spring Hill covers the cost of all sectors in Williamson County, our city limits and UGB in Maury County.
- III. Staff Request:
  - a. Staff request BFAC favorable recommendation and BOMA approve Resolution 19-25, a Resolution of intent to fund Pictometry aerial data in the GIS/IT 2019-2020 Capital Improvements budget.
