**A RESOLUTION TO PURCHASE HARLEY DAVIDSON POLICE  
MOTORCYCLE FROM LEASE AGREEMENT**

**WHEREAS**, the Spring Hill Police Department entered into a lease agreement (ref meeting and resolution #) with Harley Davidson of Columbia for a 2014 Road King Police Motorcycle; and

**WHEREAS**, the Police Department requests to purchase the Police Motorcycle which is at the end of the yearly lease; and

**WHEREAS**, the purchase price for the police motorcycle is \$11,000.00; and

**WHEREAS**, funding to purchase the police motorcycle will be from within the current fiscal budget; and


**WHEREAS**; City staff has made a recommendation to the Budget and Finance Advisory Committee.

Department Budget Status:

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I. Purpose/Overview: To purchase our currently leased 2014 Harley Davidson police motorcycle from Harley Davidson of Columbia.

II. Background Information: The police departments traffic division started a motorcycle unit in 2015 by leasing a police motorcycle from Harley Davidson of Columbia. The leasing agreement is yearly, with the option of turning in the motorcycle at the end of each year to be traded in for a new motorcycle. (as long as HD offers continues to offer this offer). Equipment would have to be transferred to the new motorcycle at a cost to the city. The police department could turn in the motorcycle and purchase a new motorcycle or not replace the motorcycle at all and we would then only have one police motorcycle in the fleet. The motorcycle unit is an asset to the traffic unit with the services they provide to the department and city. Traffic enforcement, special events, traffic crash investigations, funeral processions, and the public relations are a few areas that the unit is involved with. If approved, the funding will come from our current budget and no additional revenue is required. The motorcycle is in great running condition with no mechanical issues known.

III. Financial Impact to current Budget. \$11,000.00 Estimated, waiting for final payoff

IV. Alternative Options: continue with current lease and make yearly payments. In the future, will decide on what option to take, either buy or trade-in option.

V. Staff Recommendations: It is recommended to purchase the police motorcycle from HD of Columbia. No additional funding is required, it will be purchased from current budget. This is expected to allow us to continue our motorcycle unit with two motorcycles for 3- 5 years without replacement.
