

**RESOLUTION 19-64**

**A RESOLUTION TO AMEND FEES FOR WATERS METERS, WATER IRRIGATION METERS, FIRE HYDRANTS AND ASSOCIATED COMPONENTS**

**WHEREAS**, the amount that the City of Spring Hill can collect for water meters, water irrigation meters, fire hydrants and associated components pursuant to Ordinance 07-48, is no longer sufficient to cover the City's cost to provide same; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interest of the City and its citizens that the City of Spring Hill's charge for water meters, water irrigation meters, fire hydrants and associated components be increased to meet or exceed the City's cost to provide same.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that in reference to sprinkler irrigation taps, Section 1-108 of the Spring Hill Municipal Code is amended to read "three fourths of one (1) inch except for water meters installed to serve a sprinkler irrigation system which will be charged at the rate of ~~\$600.00~~ \$730.00 for each tap."

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that Title 18, Chapter 1, Subsection 1-108 of the Spring Hill Municipal Code relative to the charges for meters and taps should be amended to reflect the following changes:

## **STAFF MEMORANDUM**

The current rates being charged for water meter size and meter fees under Ordinance 07-48 have increased.

Relevant changes to be proposed are:

1. The current installation cost of an irrigation meter should be \$730.00 due to increase in meter fees and materials.
2. Compound meters are no longer utilized and will be replaced with Turbo series meters, which are more accurate style meters, and have increased meter fees. The meter fees for  $\frac{3}{4}$ " -  $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " meters have been increased as well.
3. The current cost of fire hydrants has increased when purchased from the vendor. Vendor is under a contract with the city to maintain pricing for up to three years.

Costs associated with the meter fees are established by National Meter & Automation (Badger) who we purchase our meters from. Meters are paid for by a builder when a building permit is pulled from the Codes department. Irrigation fees are paid an individual or home builder. All fire hydrants are sold to the developers at the same cost the city buys them at.
