WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill desires to purchase a new Freightliner cab and chassis to be used on a knuckleboom truck for brush and large item pickup service offered to the residents of the city; and

WHEREAS, the City publicly advertised for bids for these items with a bid opening on August 1, 2019; and

WHEREAS, Neely Coble Company, Inc. was the low bidder at a price of \$75,276.00 for a new cab and chassis; and

WHEREAS, funding for the purchase of a knuckleboom cab and chassis is budgeted in the 2019-2020 budget year in the Streets and Highways fund budget.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen, award the invitation to bid for the purchase of a Freightliner cab and chassis to Neely Coble Company, Inc. at a price of \$75,276.00.

STAFF MEMORANDUM

The City of Spring Hill would like to purchase a Freightliner cab and chassis that will be used for the base and body of a knuckleboom truck. This would replace an existing cab and chassis that is old (2002 model) and requires extensive service. The dump bed and hydraulic arm of the existing one will be transferred to the new pieces as those are still in good working condition. Once transferred, the old cab and chassis will be listed for sale on GovDeals.

An invitation to bid was advertised with a bid opening on August 1, 2019. The bid was open to new items with a listing of minimum qualifications that needed to be met. One bid was received – Neely Coble Company, Inc. with a cost of \$75,276.00 for a new cab and chassis.

Funding for the purchase is in the current fiscal year's budget in the Streets and Highways fund (110-43100-941), with a budgeted expense of \$85,500. This amount includes the labor to transfer the dump bed and hydraulic arm at a quoted amount of \$9,000.00, leaving \$76,500.00 for the purchase of the cab and chassis.
