

RESOLUTION 19-161

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE ALLOCATION OF ADDITIONAL STP FUNDS FOR THE WIDENING OF SR-6/US-31 (MAIN STREET) TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill has signed a contract with the Tennessee Department of Transportation to fund the NEPA Phase and a portion of the Design Phase for the widening of SR-6/US31 (Main Street) from Duplex Road to I-840 (State Project PIN 124786.00/124786.01); and

WHEREAS, Resolution 19-139 allocated funds available through the Small Cities Surface Transportation Program (STP) be applied towards this in the amount of \$832,701.69; and

WHEREAS, an additional \$445,292.31 STP funds are available and city staff recommends applying the available STP funds towards this project for a total of \$1,277,994.00.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill authorizes allocation of additional STP funds in the amount of \$445,292.31 towards widening expenses for SR-6/US-31.

STAFF MEMORANDUM

The city signed a contract with TDOT on January 22, 2019 for the widening of Main Street expenses as authorized by the BOMA with Resolution 19-09. The contract commits the city to pay a maximum of \$2,000,000 for the NEPA phase (TDOT PIN 124786.00) and any funds left over will be applied to the Design phase (TDOT PIN 124786.01).

The city had STP (federal) funds that were unobligated in the amount of \$832,701.69 that was authorized to be allocated to the Main Street widening project by Resolution 19-139. STP funds had already been requested to be applied to the Duplex Road project in the amount of \$445,292.31 per authorization by the BOMA with Resolution 19-65. We were previously told the amount for Duplex Road had not been taken out of the available STP funds but have since been told they had been taken out.

Therefore, there is an additional \$445,292.31 funds available that staff recommends be applied to the Main Street widening project, bringing the total amount allocated for PIN 124786.00/124786.01 to \$1,277,994.00.

Staff recommends approval of this resolution.
