**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE MAURY COUNTY
ELECTION COMMISSION TO CONSOLIDATE PRECINCTS AND
CONDUCT ELECTION DAY AT SPRING HILL CITY HALL FOR
THE UPCOMING ANNEXATION REFERENDUM**

WHEREAS, The City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen approved Resolution 19-147 and Resolution 19-148, which called for a referendum for annexation of properties located at 2146 Lewisburg Highway and 2154 Lewisburg Highway; and

WHEREAS, the Maury County Election Commission will meet to set a Special Election Date; and


WHEREAS, only the property owners of the proposed annexation are allowed to vote; and

WHEREAS, it would be prudent to utilize only one location for the election.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all future special elections for annexations, precincts will be consolidated and held at Spring Hill City Hall.


