Below are questions received in response to the Request for Proposal and the corresponding response from the City of Spring Hill.

Question	Response
1. Can the Department provide a copy of the 2020 shift calendar?	Yes. A copy is attached as an exhibit to Addendum 01 (see attached).
2. Will the Department consider the use of a mobile health screening facility to conduct the screening program?	Yes, the City of Spring Hill may consider the use of a mobile health screening facility to conduct the screening program. Should a proposer present such an option to conduct the screening program, the proposer should provide sufficient information on how such a facility would operate and be beneficial for the City to consider as an alternative.
3. Does the Department have a commercial grade tread mill for use by a provider to conduct the Stress test?	Yes, the City of Spring Hill Fire Department has a commercial grade tread mill that may be utilized by the provider to conduct the stress test. The proposer should provide a detailed explanation on how this device will be utilizing including any screen or separation from other areas of fire station that may be needed while testing is being performed.
4. Are the annual physical exams mandatory or voluntary for the personnel?	The annual physical exams are <u>Mandatory</u> .
5. Will the department consider the use of a mid-level healthcare provider (Nurse Practitioner, Physician assistant) to conduct the hands-on portion of the physical exam?	PROPOSERS SHOULD FOLLOW THE PROVISIONS OF THE RFP FOR THE DELIVERY OF THE HANDS-ON PORTION OF PHYSICAL EXAMS. HOWEVER, A PROPOSER MAY INCLUDE AS AN ADDITIONAL ALTERNATE FOR CONSIDERATION BY THE CITY INCLUDING CORRESPONDING PRICING AND DELIVERY METHOD UTILIZING MID-LEVEL HEALTHCARE PROVIDERS (NURSE PRACTITIONER, PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT) TO CONDUCT THE HANDS-ON PORTION OF PHYSICAL EXAMS. THE CITY RESERVES THE RIGHT TO NOT CONSIDER ALTERNATIVE DELIVERY METHODS SUCH AS UTILIZING MID-LEVEL HEALTHCARE PROVIDERS.”
6. Will the Department consider the collection of blood, urine, and TB test at one central fire department facility?	Yes, the collection of blood, urine and TB test can be done at one central location.
