

Ordinance No. 21-23

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE, AMENDING SPRING HILL MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 1, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 1-101 and 1-102 REGARDING REGULAR MEETINGS OF THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN.

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill may, pursuant to its charter and general laws of the State of Tennessee, enact regulatory ordinances protecting and promoting the general welfare, health, and safety of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Spring Hill Municipal Code, Title 1, Chapter 1, Section 1-101 currently states: "The Board of Mayor and Aldermen shall hold regular monthly meetings at 6:00 p.m. on the third Monday of each month at City Hall"; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen desires to add a second regular voting meeting.

WHEREAS, additionally, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen desires to modify the order of business at its regular meetings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT BE ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE, BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN, that Title 1, Chapter 1, Section 1-101 and Section 1-102 shall be deleted and replaced with new Sections 1-101 and 1-102 as written below:

Title 1, Chapter 1, Section 1-101

"The Board of Mayor and Aldermen shall hold regular monthly meetings at 6:00 p.m. on the first and third Monday of each month at City Hall."

Title 1, Chapter 1, Section 1-102

"At each meeting of the Board of Mayor and Alderman, the following regular order of business shall be observed unless dispensed with by a majority vote of the members present:

- (A) Call to Order by Mayor;***
- (B) Stipulation of Members Present;***
- (C) Approval of the Agenda;***
- (D) Communication from the Mayor;***
- (E) Reports from committees, members of the Board of Mayor and Alderman and other officers;***
- (F) Comments from Concerned Citizens;***
- (G) Approval of minutes of the previous meeting;***
- (H) Public Hearing;***
- (I) Voting Agenda;***
 - (a) Approval of Consent Agenda***

- (b) Previous Business**
- (c) New Business**
- (J) Work Session Discussion**
- (K) Adjourn**


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that all Ordinances in conflict are repealed or changed accordingly.

RE: Amending Ordinance §1-101 and §1-102

This ordinance would amend §1-101 of the Spring Hill Code to reflect our new meeting schedule of having two voting meetings per month rather than just one to reflect our newly updated practice. The only change to §1-101, as shown below, is to add the words "first and" before the word "third" in the current ordinance.

"The Board of Mayor and Aldermen shall hold regular monthly meetings at 6:00 p.m. on the **first and** third Monday of each month at City Hall."

This ordinance would also amend §1-102 to reflect our newly established meeting schedule. §1-102 would be replaced in its entirety with a new §1-102.
