A RESOLUTION APPROVING RECOMMENDATION OF PROJECTS FOR THE NEIGHBORHOOD SIDEWALK PROGRAM PLAN FOR FY 2020-2021


WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen recognized the need to adopt neighborhood sidewalk policies and procedures to address citizen recreation and safety concerns within residential neighborhoods by adopting Resolution 14-25; and

WHEREAS, the City Staff advertised and accepted applications for sidewalks and, in conjunction with the City's Transportation and Advisory Committee, has identified the following sidewalk priorities for fiscal year 2020-2021:

1. Crowne Pointe Homeowners Association (North side of Stewart Campbell Point between New Port Royal Road and Lantana Drive)
2. Chapman's Retreat (Finish connectivity from the entrance to Duplex Road)
3. Wakefield (Finish connectivity from Masonboro Drive to Duplex Road)
4. Dewey Drive (South side of Dewey Drive between Commonwealth Drive and Portway Road)



STAFF MEMORANDUM

The purpose of this memo is to provide information regarding a resolution to approve selections for sidewalk projects for the FY 2020-2021 Neighborhood Sidewalk Program.

Background:

City staff advertised for submissions for the NSP for fiscal year 2020-2021. Eight submissions were received, with one matching contribution (Crown Pointe HOA - 27% match). All eight were evaluated and ranked by staff and a recommendation to fund four of the projects was presented to the Transportation Advisory Committee in December 2019.

TAC made the recommendation to approve the following projects and costs:

1. Crowne Pointe Homeowners Association (North side of Stewart Campbell Point between New Port Royal Road and Lantana Drive)
2. Chapman's Retreat (Finish connectivity from the entrance to Duplex Road)
3. Wakefield (Finish connectivity from Masonboro Drive to Duplex Road)
4. Dewey Drive (South side of Dewey Drive between Commonwealth Drive and Portway Road)

Total expense is \$180,435.00 with Crown Pointe HOA submitting \$13,560.75 towards their project, netting a cost to the city of \$166,874.25. Expenditure will be from line item 110-43100-272 (Streets and Highways – New Sidewalks). (FY 2019-2020 budget for line item 110-43100-272 was \$150,000.00.) Contributing revenue will be recognized in line item 110-34315 (Receipts for Roads and Sidewalks).
