**WHEREAS**, the City of Spring Hill has purchased aerial data from Pictometry International Corp, sole-source provider, in the past; and



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- I. Purpose/Overview of Purchase: Spring Hill GIS department participates in purchasing aerial data from Pictometry with Maury County.
- II. Background Information:
  - a. Spring Hill has participated with Maury County and Williamson County for several years in the Pictometry flights. Maury County is maintaining a three-year flight cycle. Pictometry worked with Spring Hill to include the Williamson County city limits area. Pictometry also agreed to expanded aerial data collection to the east to cover Williamson County properties between I-65 to Lewisburg Pike at Spring Hill's request.
  - b. Pictometry flight was delayed due to severe flooding last February, flight is currently on schedule. Estimated delivery data of day is 21 days after flight.
  - c. BOMA passed Resolution 19-25, a resolution of intent to fund Pictometry Aerial Data.
  - d. This is a budgeted Item.
- III. Staff Request: BOMA authorize expenditure of \$18,000 to purchase the city's portion of the Pictometry Aerial Data.
