
**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN EXPENDITURE FOR

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill subscribed to Microsoft Office 365 G1 user subscriptions last year; and

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen passed Resolution 19-124 authorizing the subscriptions from Dell Technologies, Round Rock, TX which included three years of annual support for \$22,722 per year for 300 users; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee that an expenditure of approximately \$22,722 is hereby authorized for the second annual Microsoft Office 365 G1 subscriptions and support from Dell Technologies, Round Rock, TX, as recommended by staff.
