**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES  
FOR THE PUBLIC (TOP) GRANT FROM THE TENNESSEE STATE

**WHEREAS**, the Spring Hill Public Library applied for a Training Opportunities for the Public (TOP) to enhance the current library WIFI hotspot program with Children's Internet Protection Act (CIPA)-compliant (filtered) hotspots for student use; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen authorized application for grant funds on April 19, 2021; and


**WHEREAS**, the Library has been selected to receive a grant in the amount of \$1,207.50, while matching with \$362.25.


