**STAFF MEMORANDUM**

With BOMA approval, library staff intend to apply for American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding that is designated specifically for libraries through the Tennessee State Library and Archives. The request totals \$35,476.60 with a local match of 20%, or just under \$6,000 (included in total). This \$6,000 would come from the CIP money already approved in the FY 21-22 library budget for upgraded computers.

Included in the request are 6 laptops and docking stations for staff, 12 computer carrels for the public, 2 portable sound dampening units for patron computing, a Tech Tub, books and e-books.

Staff requests the approval of Resolution 21-XX.
