**PURPOSE:**

The purpose of this resolution is to approve the donation of a 2002 Freightliner FL8 fire engine to Maury County Fire Department.

**BACKGROUND:**

The City has purchased a new 2021 Pierce custom pump truck to replace an older fire engine (2010 Pierce custom Freightliner truck) in existing fleet. The 2010 Pierce will be a reserve truck if needed. The 2002 Freightliner (VIN 1FVABXBS02DK04173) that was the reserve truck has exceeded the recommended service life of 15 years. Maury County Fire Department is in a need of an engine truck and the Spring Hill Fire Department requests approval to donate the 2002 Freightliner to their organization to serve the needs of the services they provide. The estimated value of the donated engine is \$20,000.00.

**FINANCIAL IMPACT:**

No financial impact for the City of Spring Hill.
