

**RESOLUTION NO. 21-148**

**A RESOLUTION DIRECTING STAFF TO EXPLORE AND ADVISE ON  
ESTABLISHING A TIERED RATE STRUCTURE FOR NON-ESSENTIAL  
IRRIGATION**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Spring Hill has experienced tremendous growth that is challenging to keep pace with the need to design, build, construct, operate, and maintain adequate infrastructure; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Spring Hill is behind schedule on securing additional water supply and capacity for the system; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Spring Hill continues to experience drought conditions, and the City has had to cut-off supply to residents and businesses on several occasions to maintain adequate water operations for essential potable water service; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen desire to direct the future growth of Spring Hill in a responsible manner.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen, that staff shall investigate establishing a new irrigation policy focused on creating a tiered rate structure based on non-essential irrigation usage. The purpose of the policy is to assist with reducing non-essential potable water usage for irrigation while still providing the opportunity for residents and businesses to irrigate.
