

RESOLUTION 21-166

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND RESOLUTION 21-109 TO AUTHORIZE THE PURCHASE OF PICKUP TRUCKS FOR PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENTS THROUGH STATE CONTRACT

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen approved the purchase of six 2021 pickup trucks from Wilson County Motors through State contract award pricing by Resolution 21-109; and

WHEREAS, the Chevrolet 1500 trucks are not available due to manufacturer shortage and Streets and Highways department requests to purchase a 2021 Ford F-150 in lieu of the Chevrolet 1500; and

WHEREAS, the State contract pricing through Wilson County Motors is:

2021 Chevrolet Silverado 1500 - \$32,155.53 (Streets and Highways); and

WHEREAS, the State contract pricing through Ford of Murfreesboro is:

2021 Ford F-150 Crew Cab - \$33,724.00 (Streets and Highways); and

WHEREAS, funding for the purchase of the trucks is budgeted in the 2021-2022 budget year in the Streets and Highways department (110-43100-943 - \$97,000.00).

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen, authorize the amendment to Resolution 21-109 to purchase a 2021 Ford F-150 Crew Cab from Ford of Murfreesboro in lieu of a 2021 Chevrolet 1500 from Wilson County Motors for a total price of \$33,724.00 through State contract.
